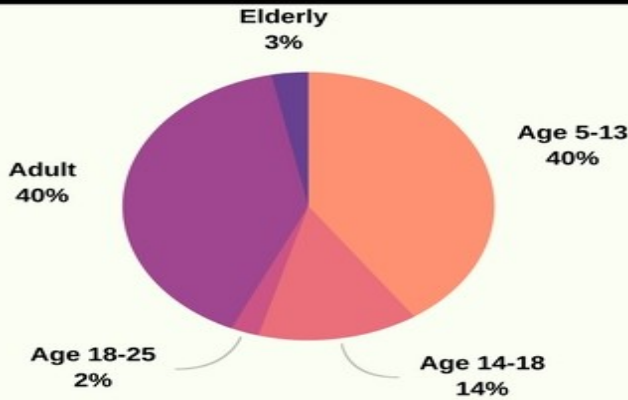

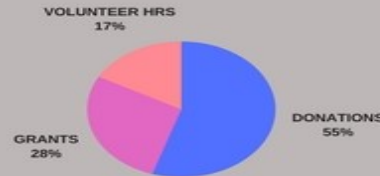
RESULTS OF A CHILDHOOD BEREAVEMENT STUDY

of respondents believe their life would have been "much better" if their parent hadn't died so young.

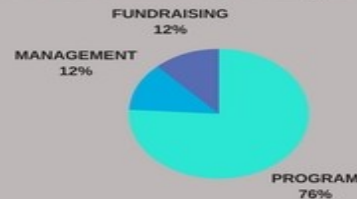
